1. Select Your Pitch:

On the right hand side of the interface, select your desired pitch view from a range of options


2. Drag & Drop:

Select the required player model and drag & drop onto the 360° Pitch...










... using the tabs on the left hand side select, drag & drop equipment lines and text to formulate the session.

Comments can be added and views changed at the footer of the interface beneath the 3D window

1. My Sessions

Click on My Session tab.
This is your own personal session library where all your created sessions are stored.

2. Session Builder

Click the Session Builder tab to access a session building library of all your drills. Here you can create a complete session in seconds



3. Session Overviews

When entering the session builder you will see a library of every drill you have saved. This can be filtered using the search engine on the left.

By clicking on the view more beneath each thumbnail you can open individual session overviews as shown. From this you can choose the drills that best suit the session you are creating.




4. Drag & Drop

Open up your session Library by clicking the main tab




2. Select A Session


1. My Sessions

The 'My Sessions' Library is where all of your privately created sessions are kept and can only be viewed by you.




2. Club Sessions

4. Session Library

The 'Session Library' is also known the World Wide Library, this is available to all our members. There are currently over 7000 drills available to you.

Match Time is a two-tier system that allows a coach to both prepare for and analyse matches.

Preparation - This allows the coach to prepare his team sheet, formations & set piece routines prior to kick off.

Analysis - During the real time play (or watching replay) the coach can log minute by minute actions from the game. This includes goals, bookings, substitutes and set pieces to name a few. This information is then stored into the match library for ease of access and printing.



1. Creating Your Team

In the team tab, click on the 'add player' button to enter a players name, position and number. Click save.



Set the number of players and venue



Select the amount of information displayed



Select home and away formations



Define specific event times



Event list displayed chronologically



Select and add match periods





Add set pieces and set plays

2. Matches

Access your matches via the 'My Sessions' page. This houses the library of all your Match Day documents. Here you can enter the view match page by clicking on the title or thumbnail of your saved match



3. View Match Page

Once you have selected your specific match from the library you can view all the data captured during the match analysis.

Formations will appear for each period along with a detailed match report listing all events documented in chronological order stating names, times and incidents.





Match periods are separated to allow for half time formation changes etc.

Adding videos to your saved sessions and matches is a great tool for you and your players

- **1. Enter the Library -** Enter your saved session library via the "My Sessions" tab to see your list of session and matches you have created.
- **2. Select the Session -** Select the desired match or session you wish to add a video too by clicking on the thumbnail or session title.



3. Editing the Session

Once you have entered the session page the you wish to add a video too, click on the "Edit Page" tab.

Here you will be able to change the session title, categories, descriptions etc and add your YouTube video





4. Entering the URL - When in the "Edit Session" page scroll down to the "Attach YouTube Video" section at the bottom.

On a separate internet window, find and select the required video on YouTube, select and copy the website address (URL).

Returning to SSP, paste/enter the YouTube address into the blank box provided.

Finally click on the "Attach" tab.

You will then see the YouTube video is showing.
